There were 184 individual swims with 118 best times reported. Our BT percentage was 64%, NPAC swimmers posted 25 new Star Times—8 from the girls

and 17 from the boys! There were 13 new B times, 6 BB, 5 A, and I AA. For the Junior Olympics April 26-29 in Anchorage, there are fifteen qualifiers. Group Championship meet February 24-26 in Juneau. Three swimmers made cuts for the championship for the very first time. All three of these swimmers can have the opportunity to make more cuts in the Novice Invite December 10th. For the Great Alaska Open in Anchorage February 17-19—five new qualifying swims were posted

by Josh Handeland, Justice Kramer, Kelsey Nore, and Sean Preece. For the Alaska Junior Olympics in Anchorage April 26-29, eight new qualifying swims were posted by Jessica Williamson, Josh Handeland, Kelsey Nore, and Josiah Winans. Two new qualifiers made their first cuts for the April championship. They are Patrick McIntosh in the 100 Fly and Joseph Villa in the 50 Free and 100 Fly. Overall, the Wishbone meet went extremely well. We were quite impressed to see all of the fast Star Times and qualifying times that were posted by our awesome NPAC swimmers. We hope everyone is doing all they can to participate in the upcoming travel championship meets. It's a sacrifice financially, but is such an awesome and rewarding accomplishment for your athletes. 
